ORDER

Upon consideration of the parties' Joint Motion Requesting Dismissal of Action Without Prejudice, and this Court finding that good cause for the relief therein prayed has been shown, it is this 21st day of April, 2010 by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia,

ORDERED that this action be, and the same hereby is, dismissed without prejudice;

ORDERED that eighteen (18) months after the date of this Order, plaintiff may file a motion to reinstate his claims, provided that said motion must be filed within 30 days of the expiration of said 18 month period upon the terms and conditions set forth in the executed Settlement Agreement between the parties;

ORDERED that, if this Court denies the motion to reinstate the case, or plaintiff fails to timely seek to reinstate this lawsuit, the dismissal herein granted shall be deemed to be with prejudice;

ORDERED that, if this action is reinstated pursuant to a motion to reinstate, (1) the case shall be returned to the *status quo* existing at the time of this dismissal; (2) the parties shall jointly seek appropriate relief to secure scheduling of the remaining proceedings; and (3) the District shall not assert the statute of limitations or the doctrine of laches with respect to the period during which the case was dismissed.
